RESOLUTION

ON APPROVAL OF THE REQUIREMENTS ON COMPLIANCE WITH TRANSPORT SECURITY FOR INDIVIDUALS FOLLOWING OR LOCATED AT TRANSPORT INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES OR VEHICLES, BY TYPE OF TRANSPORT

In accordance with Article 8 of the Federal Law 'On Transport Security', the Government of the Russian Federation has resolved:

To approve the attached requirements for compliance with transport security for individuals following or located at transport infrastructure facilities or vehicles, by type of transport.

REQUIREMENTS ON COMPLIANCE WITH TRANSPORT SECURITY FOR INDIVIDUALS FOLLOWING OR LOCATED AT TRANSPORT INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES OR VEHICLES, BY TYPE OF TRANSPORT

- 1. This document defines the requirements for observing transport safety for individuals following or located at transport infrastructure facilities or vehicles of various transportation means.
- 2. Individuals who follow or are located at a transport infrastructure facility or vehicle are required to:
 - a) carry out passage (travel) to the transport security zone in accordance with the rules of inspection, additional inspection and repeated inspection for the purpose of ensuring transport security, including a list of necessary documents established by the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation in coordination with the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation and the Federal Security Service of the Russian Federation;
 - b) comply with the requirements of transport security forces aimed at ensuring transport security, as well as not to take actions that preclude them from performing their official duties;
 - c) inform transport security forces on events or actions that pose a threat to transport safety of the transport infrastructure facility or vehicle.
- 3. It is prohibited for individuals who are either at a transport infrastructure facility or vehicle to:

- a) carry (transport) objects and substances prohibited or restricted for circulation at the transport infrastructure facility and/or vehicle into the transport security zone;
- b) impede the functioning of technical means of ensuring transport safety located in the transport security zone;
- c) accept material objects for their transportation in a vehicle without notifying transport security forces and passing the inspection procedure in cases stipulated by the requirements for ensuring transport security established in accordance with Article 8 of the Federal Law 'On Transport Safety';
- d) take actions that create obstacles (including use of vehicles and other technical means) to operation of the vehicle or restrict the functioning of transport infrastructure facilities, including the dissemination of knowingly false messages about events or actions that pose a threat to transport safety of transport infrastructure facility or vehicle, and actions aimed at the damage (theft) of elements of the transport infrastructure facility or vehicle, which can bring them to an unusable condition or condition that threatens life or health of the personnel of the transport infrastructure facility or the transport safety unit, passengers and other persons;
- e) transfer documents to third parties granting the right to pass the inspection procedure in a special fashion for passage (travel) to the transport security zone;
- f) to pass (travel) to the transport security zone of a transport infrastructure facility or vehicle outside (bypassing) the passages (drives) established by the transport infrastructure facility or the carrier;
- g) take actions that simulate preparation for commission of acts of unlawful interference with the operation of a transport infrastructure facility or vehicle;
- h) use pyrotechnic devices without permission of the person responsible for ensuring transport security at the transport infrastructure facility or vehicle;
- i) use small-size self-propelled and non-self-propelled vessels (watercrafts) in the seaport water areas used for boarding (disembarking) passengers and/or transshipment of high-risk cargoes determined by binding regulations of the seaport approved by the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation.
