

In accordance with Order No. 104 of the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation to the Rules of pre-flight and post-flight inspections the following items of property and substances may be transported on board the aircraft by crew members and passengers, provided the applicable requirements are complied with:

1.1) If transported within checked-in baggage, in cargo and baggage compartments of the aircraft, with no access for the passengers to the baggage during the flight:

- crossbows, spear fishing rifles, cavalry swords, sabers, cleavers, scimitars, broadswords, swords, court swords, bayonets, daggers, hunting knives, ballistic knives, lockable-lock knives or imitators of any type of weapons
- household knives (scissors) with blade length more than 60 mm
- alcoholic beverages containing more than 24%, but not more than 70% alcohol by volume, in containers with a capacity of not more than 5 liters, in containers intended for retail sales – not more than 5 liters per passenger
- liquids and alcoholic beverages containing not more than 24% alcohol by volume
- aerosols intended for use in sports or household purposes, if exhaust valves of their containers are protected by caps against spontaneous release of the contents, in containers with a capacity of not more than 0.5 kg or 500 ml - not more than 2 kg or 2 liters per passenger

1.2) if transported in items of property carried on by passengers:

- medical thermometer – one per passenger
- mercury tonometer in a standard case - one per passenger
- mercury barometer or manometer, packed in an airtight container and sealed with the sender's seal
- disposable lighters - one per passenger
- dry ice for cooling perishable food - not more than 2 kg per passenger
- 3% hydrogen peroxide - not more than 100 ml per passenger
- non-hazardous liquids, gels and aerosols:
 - if transported in containers with a capacity of not more than 100 ml (or an equivalent capacity in other volume measurement units), packed in a securely closed transparent plastic bag with a volume of not more than 1 liter - one bag per passenger
 - liquids in containers with a capacity of more than 100 ml are not acceptable for transportation, even if the container is only partially filled, with the exception of:
- medicinal drugs, baby food and products for special dietary needs

Liquids purchased from duty-free shops at the airport or on board the aircraft must be packed in a securely sealed plastic bag that provides identification of access to the contents of the bag during the flight, on which there is reliable confirmation that the purchase was made at the airport duty-free shops or on board the aircraft on the date (s) of travel.

The administrative authority of the airport, airline or operator may decide, at its own discretion, to introduce any additional measures to ensure aviation security on any high-risk flights and therefore prohibit the transportation of any of the following items of property in the cabin of an aircraft:

- corkscrews
- hypodermic needles (unless medical justification is provided for their transportation)
- knitting needles
- scissors with a blade length less than 60 mm
- folding knives (without any fixation device) for travels, penknives with length of blade less than 60 mm.
